A Morgantown native will spend 2002 at Oxford University as one of 40 British Marshall Scholars selected by the British Embassy in Washington, D.C.

Zachary Kaufman, who graduated from Yale with a degree in political science, works for the Justice Department in Washington, D.C., and serves as director of the American Friends of the Kigali Public Library. Kaufman is a human rights proponent who has been a presenter at numerous government and human rights conferences in Russia, The Hague, and the Embassy of the Republic of Rwanda.

The Marshall scholarships were established in 1953 às a British gesture of thanks to the United States for financial assistance offered at the end of World War II under the Marshall Plan. Past scholars include Supreme Court Justice Stephen Breyer, and Tom Friedman, foreign affairs columnist of *The New York*

Times.
